## EXPLORE AFRICAN LANDS



Designed in multi layers with a multi level loop texture creating an abstract interpretation of the African landscapes, enhanced by metallic yarns creating a unique light reflection and finished to detail with custom colors matched to samples from nature curated on my African trip.

Since the Montgolfier is all about nature and applauding the beauty of this world, no sacrifice was made. It was only normal that the regenerated ECONYL® yarns were selected to create this tribute to a continent that is at the core of our human history.

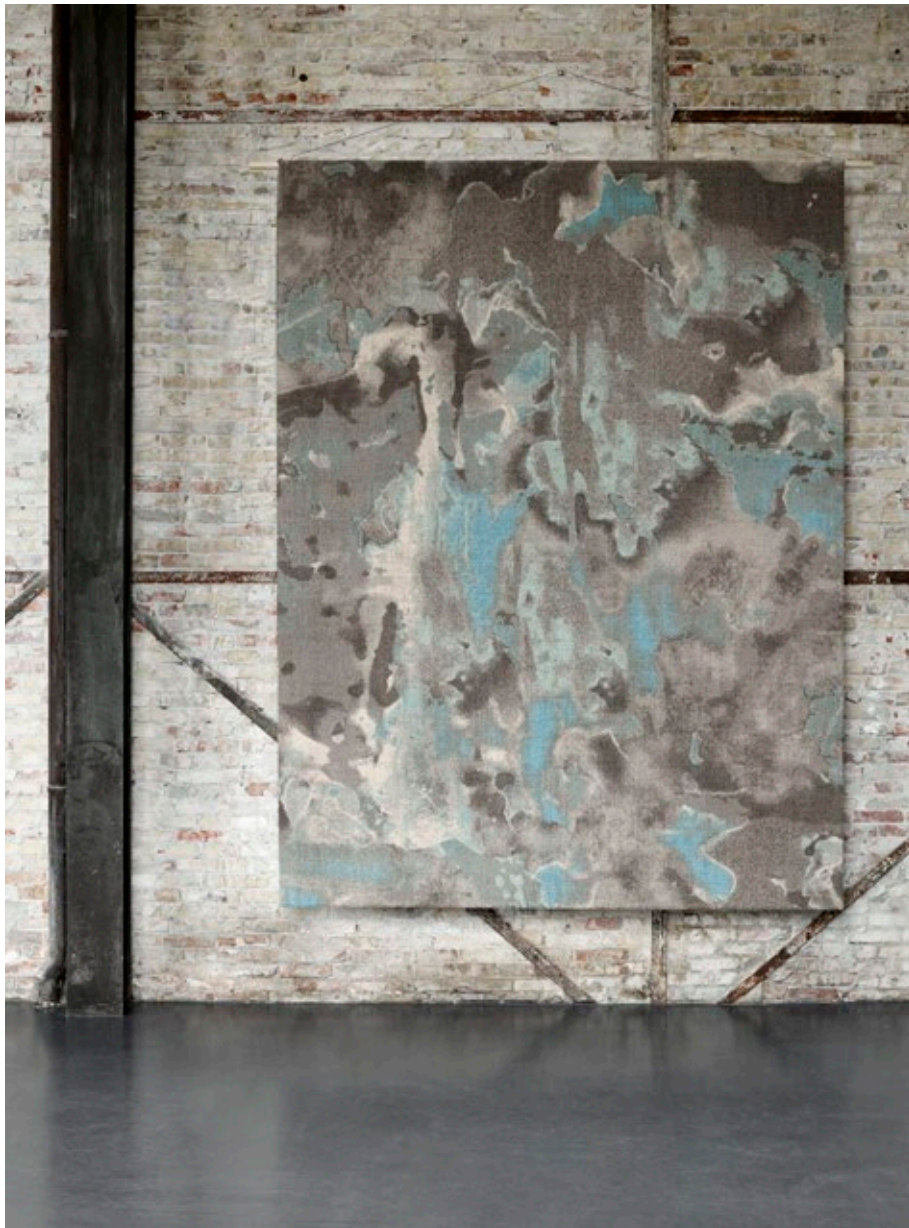
